

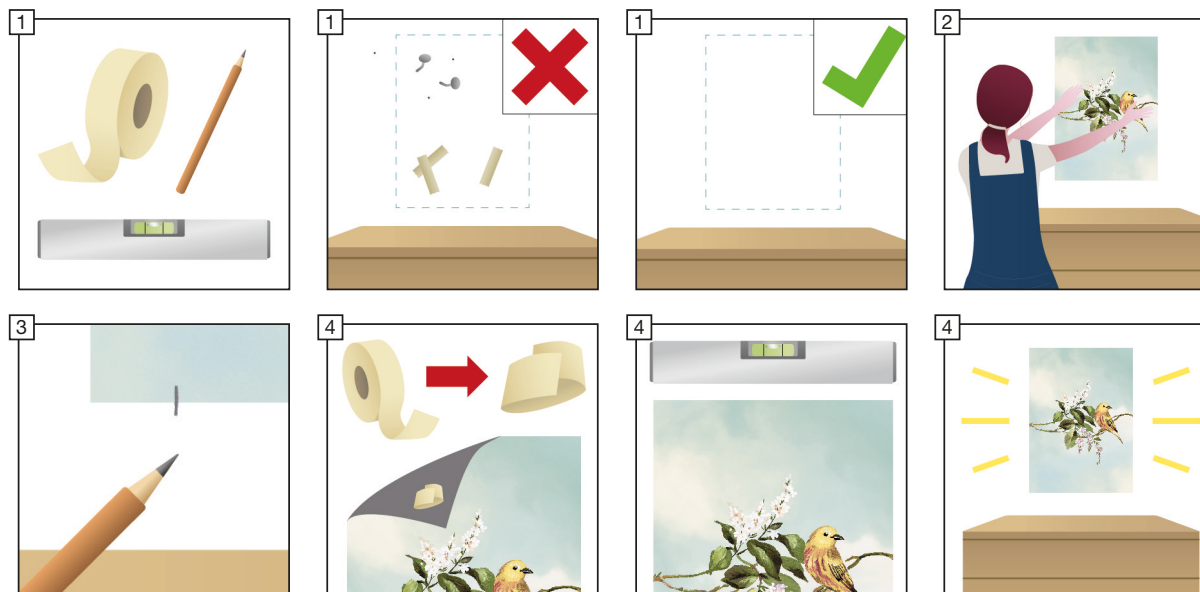


Instructions for hanging posters:

1. preparation: To hang up a poster, you must ensure that all the necessary materials are available. You will need a mounting option (e.g. double-sided adhesive tape or a special poster holder), a spirit level (optional, but helpful for a straight result), a pencil and, of course, the poster. You should also make sure that there are no old nails, hooks or similar stuck in the wall to ensure a flat surface. For optimum results, make sure that the wall is clean and dry.

2. finding the right position: The poster should be held against the wall in advance and, if necessary, different positions tested to find the best placement.

3. marking the position: As soon as the optimum position has been found, the spot should be marked lightly with a pencil or a piece of adhesive tape on the top and bottom of the poster and on the wall.



4. hang and align the poster: Attach the poster to the wall using the chosen mounting option (adhesive tape, poster holder...) - follow the respective manufacturer's instructions for an optimal experience. Also make sure once again that it is hanging firmly and straight. If the poster is still not hanging straight (this can be checked with a spirit level), the position should be corrected again.

Admire the result: Take a step back and admire the poster, which is now hanging perfectly on the wall.
